



How can I apply for an audition?

Open auditions are held in May each year for entry to the programme in September. Applicants must complete and return an audition application form before Friday 9 May 2014 to reserve a place on their preferred audition date. Please return your completed application form to the address provided at the bottom of this page.

What happens at an ATP audition?

There are two stages to the ATP audition process. Applicants will attend a First Stage Open Audition which will consist of a short ballet class and a contemporary technique and creative movement class. Applicants will receive a letter no later than two weeks after the First Stage Audition to inform them whether or not they were successful at this stage.

Applicants who are successful at the First Stage Audition will then be invited to a Second Stage Audition, where they will take part in another classical and contemporary dance class. A list of names will be put up straight after this audition class to indicate which applicants have been asked to stay behind for an interview and physical screening. Interviews will take place with the CAT Manager. Applicants are also required to undergo a physical screening with the Student Health and Well Being Coordinator to check their long term suitability for contemporary dance training at this level. Applicants must be accompanied by a parent or carer during the interview and physical screening process.

After Second Stage Audition you will receive a letter by Friday 27 June 2014 to inform you whether or not you have been offered a place on the ATP for September. If you are successful you will be invited to the Summer Induction days which will take place on Monday 21 and Tuesday 22 July 2014.
