Martin Corri : Kylian Rep Falling Angels/ Sarabande & Gaga technique

Monday 23, Tuesday 24 & Wednesday 25 February

Kylian Rep (Ballet): 11.30am – 1.30pm

Gaga technique (Contemporary): 2.30 – 4.30pm

After graduating from the Royal Ballet School, Martin joined The Netherlands Dance Theatre 1 & 2 under the directorship of Jiri Kylian, working with Ohad Naharin, William Forsythe, Matz Ek, Hans van Manen, Nacho Duato and Jiri Kylian himself. He went on to perform, rehearsal direct and teach with the Kibbutz Contemporary Dance Company with Rami Beer and the Kombina Dance Company with Amir Kolben, both based in Israel. Since then he has worked as guest teacher with Gallili Dance, Michael Clark Company, Rambert Dance Company, National Dance Company Wales, and as Ballet Master with Batsheva Ensemble, Vertigo, the Vienna Festival Ballet and many more.

Martin teaches classical ballet, contemporary, improvisation, gaga, meditation and choreography.

Lucy Carter: How lighting design and technology are transforming dance

Tuesday 10 March, 1 – 3pm

Lucy Carter is at the forefront of lighting design, working internationally with choreographers and companies including the Royal Ballet, Wayne McGregor with Random Dance, San Francisco Ballet, Ballet of the Opéra de Paris, Stuttgart Ballet, New York City Ballet, Sadler's Wells, and Scottish Ballet. Lucy has strong feelings about the power and possibilities of light. "It affects everything." As a dance student she found herself becoming more interested in lighting pieces than choreographing them, and in the last 20 years, it has taken her to the forefront of whole generation of designers who have taught dance audiences to see light in new ways.

Constance Humphries: Dance Video workshop

Monday 11, Tuesday 12 May | 11.30am – 5pm

This two-day workshop will introduce basic dance video concepts, video recording techniques and simple audio/video editing. Day 1 will focus on introductions, creating choreography and recording. Day 2 will focus on editing audio video and software.

Constance Humphries' career as a performer, creator, and exhibitor has spanned more than 20 years, working internationally and based in North Carolina until re-location to the North East in 2014. With a Masters in Information Science, a Bachelor of Fine Arts, as an international dancer and latterly a lecturer in online media, she has developed an extensive portfolio of dance film working with a range of collaborators across art forms. Now based in the North East her intention is to create opportunities for dance artists and makers to produce their own dance films and to initiate a dance film festival in the future.
