

Q&A's About the Relaxed Performance

•**Who can come to a relaxed performance?**

Anyone that would benefit from a relaxed performance including people with an Autism Spectrum Condition, sensory and communication disorders or a learning disability (and their parents/guardians/carers).

•**Can I see the theatre before the show?**

Yes, the doors to the theatre will be opening early and you're welcome to go in and have a look around.

•**Will there be anywhere quiet I can go if I need to?**

Yes, we will be making a studio available as a comfortable 'break out zone' for anyone who wishes to take time out during the performance.

•**Can I take food and drink into the show?**

Yes, you are welcome to take food and drinks into the theatre.

•**Can I film and take photos of the show?**

Yes, absolutely.

•**Will it be dark in the theatre?**

The house lights will stay on for a little bit longer than usual, and the theatre will remain light throughout the entire show. There will be no total blackout at any time.

•**Will the theatre be crowded?**

For this performance we have reduced the seating capacity so that there will be more room in the theatre and no one will feel cramped.

•**Am I still allowed into the theatre if I'm late?**

Yes, with a relaxed performance we are really flexible and understand that it might take a while for you to get to the theatre.

•**Will there be staff to ask questions?**

Yes, we will have plenty of staff in to support your visit and answer any questions you may have.

•**Will there be space in the theatre for wheelchairs?**
