

## **Programme Lead 2018**

Curious Festival 2018 Young Peoples Programme Lead, supported by Arts Council England.

Opportunity: Curious Arts is seeking applications for the role of Young Peoples Programme Lead, to support the development and delivery of Curious Festival 2018's young peoples programme on Sunday 1st July. We are keen to hear from individuals or partnerships with experience of working with children and young people and diverse communities within the arts and culture sector.

The Young Peoples Programme Lead role involves:

- Supporting up to six existing young peoples groups to create a number of short artistic ideas and presentations. Developed at the Curious Festival Queer Creative Challenge day at Northern Stage on Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> June.
- Delivering one up to sixty-minute contact session per young peoples group, hosted at their regular meeting space in Newcastle upon Tyne, between Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> and Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> June.
- Supporting the young peoples groups to present their work, ideas and works in progress at Curious Festival 2018's launch event hosted at Live Theatre on Sunday 1st July.
- Being the young peoples main contact for their involvement with Curious Festival 2018.

Applicants for this role must be DBS checked and able to travel to venues across Newcastle upon Tyne for contact session/event delivery. The role requires flexibility from Saturday 9th June to Sunday 1st July and involves evening/weekend work to accommodate the supported groups.

We welcome applications via CV and cover letter detailing your experience and why you want to work with Curious Arts as Young Peoples Programme Lead. Shortlisted applicants will be invited to interview/discuss the role.

Fee: £600-£750 - Two days of event delivery (Sat 9th June & Sun 1st July) and up to six one-hour contact sessions. This fee includes travel within Newcastle upon Tyne.
